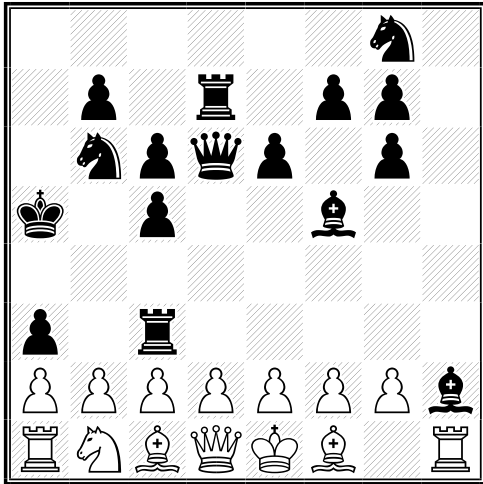

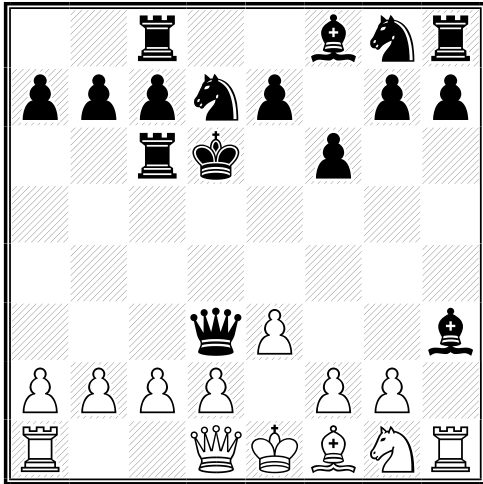

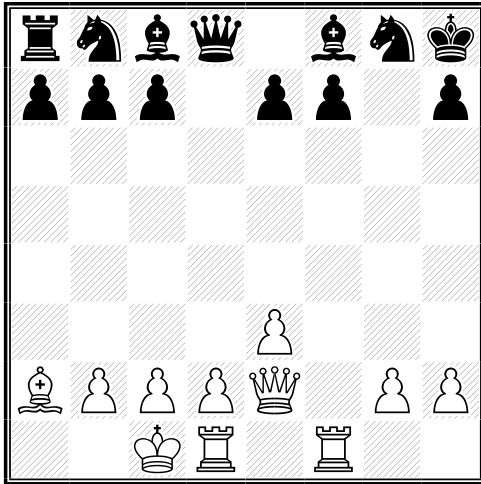

Royal Dynasty

Each side can have one or more Kings. Pawns may promote to King. When a side has one King, that King is royal and is subject to check and mate, just like in orthodox chess. But when a side has more than one King, none of them are royal, and all are immune to check and mate.

Castling is only allowed with a royal King which has not moved since it became royal (again). In this game, the white King plays 0-0, becomes non-royal on move 10, returns to e1, becomes royal again after 13. ... ♚xh8 and is thus allowed to play 0-0-0.

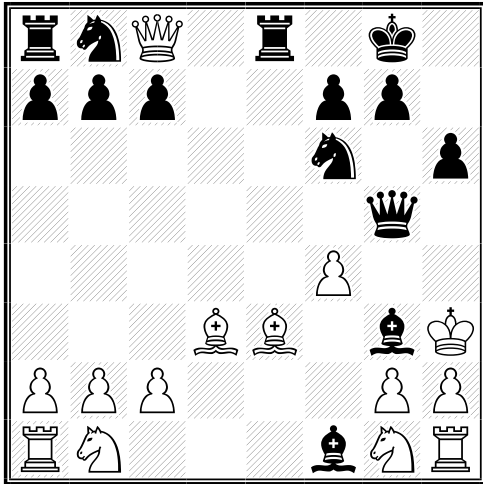
