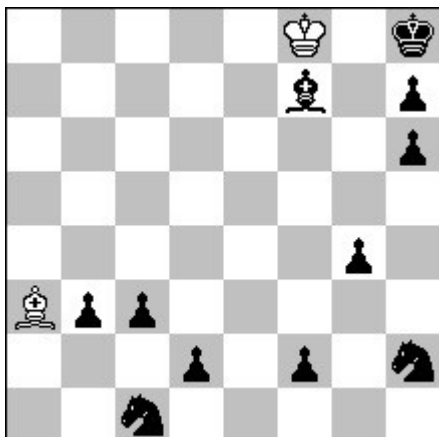

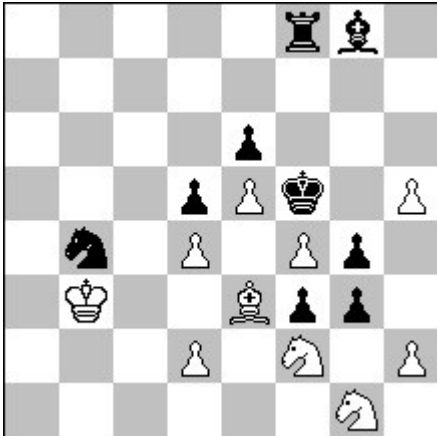

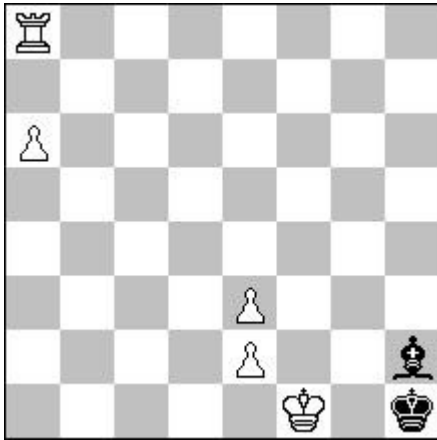
Double pendulum manouever by White Knight and Black King.

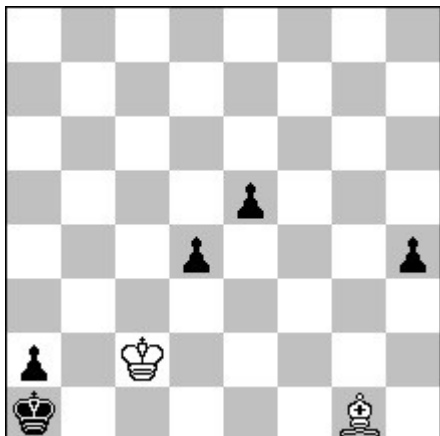

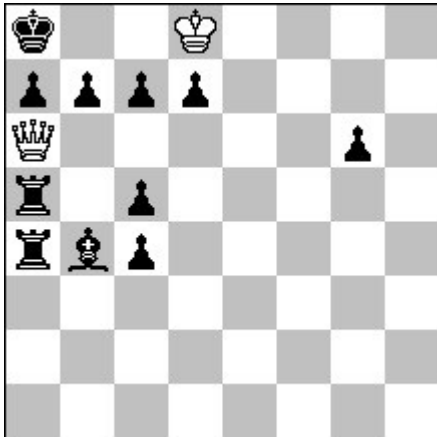

1. ... Bc3 2. Qf8 Bg7 3. Qe8 a6 4. Kxc7+ Ka7 5. Qb8#

1. ... Ra6 2. Qh8 (2. Qf8? Rf6!) Bc3 3. Qg8 Bf6/Re6 4. Kxc7/Kxd7+ Bd8/Re8 5. Qxd8/Qxe8#

White minimal. PlatzWechslung between White Queen and Black King. White Queen goes to all fields along the 8th rank, and mates on 5 of them (a-e).
