1.Rg3+ 1.Rh3+? Ke4! 2.Rg4+ Kf5 3.Rg7 c1Q 4.Rf3+ Ke4, =. 1.Rh1? hxg5, =.

1...Kd2 2.Rh1, with two lines:

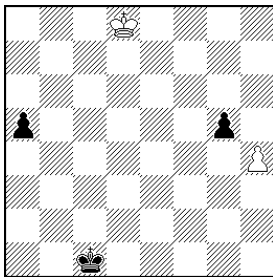

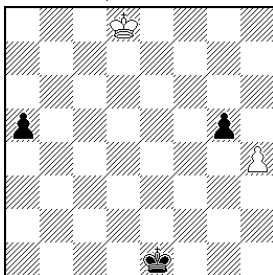

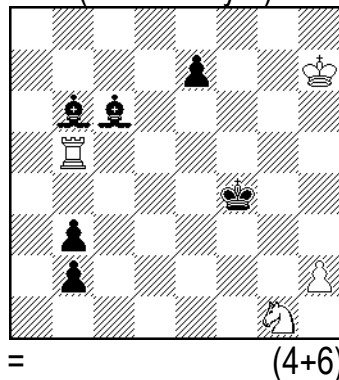
