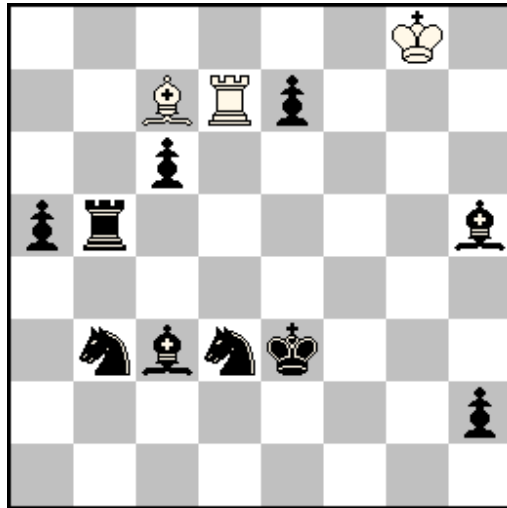
#### Solution :

1.Re5 bxc4+ 2.Qxc4 Rd6‡  
1.Qd6 Rxc4 2.Be5 Se3‡

Squares e3 and d6, where mates will be given, are initially guarded by the same four black pieces. BR and BB perform a Grimshaw, BS is captured and BQ transfers a self-block. Interchange of place between WR and BQ on final positions.

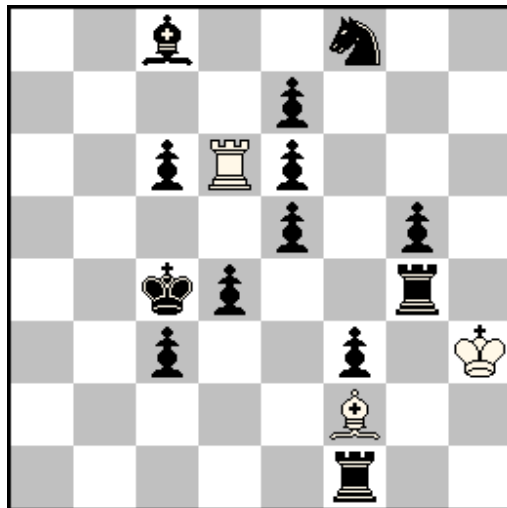

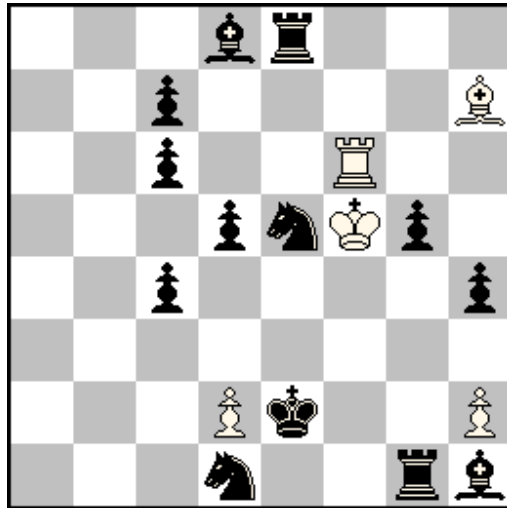
