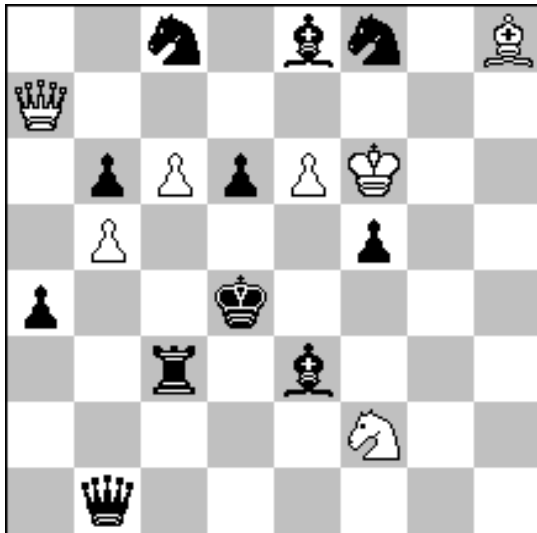

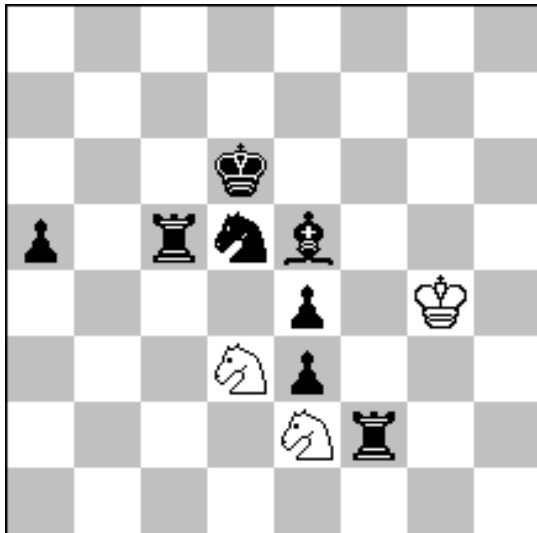
cycle of fields c4, c5, d5 (2x controlled by wQ + 1x blocked by black)

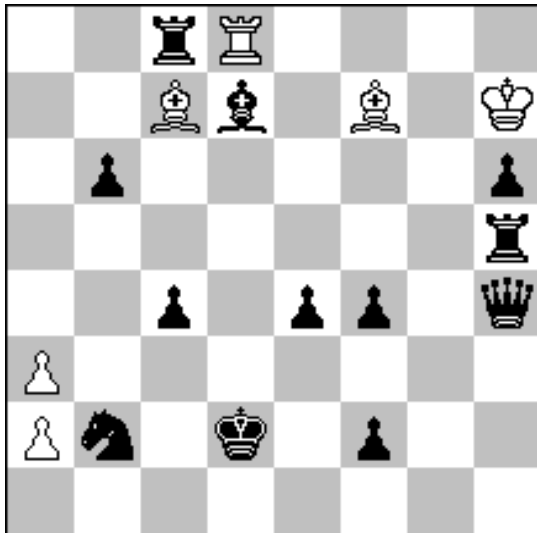

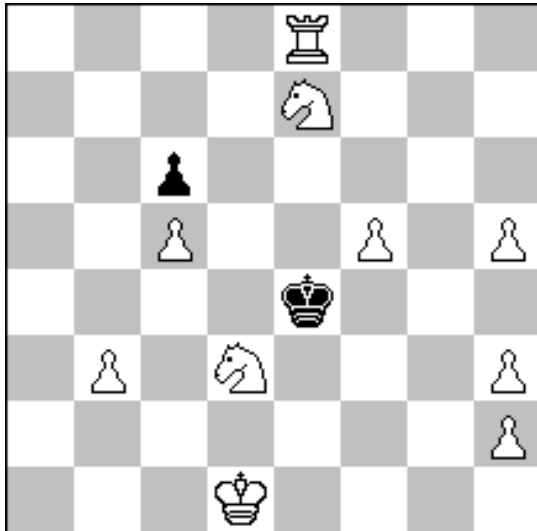

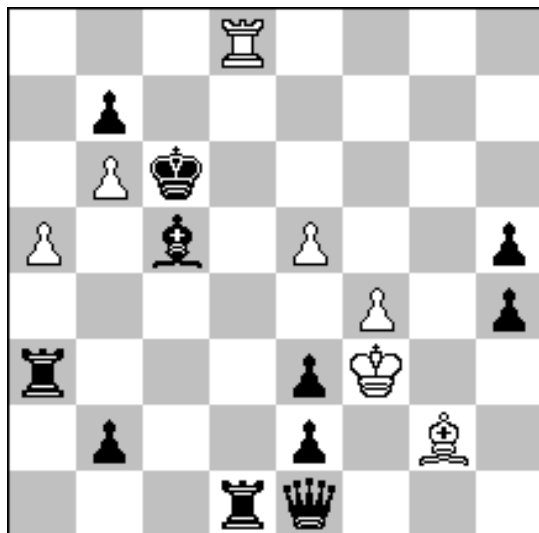

2x unguard of a field and block on b5; 2xline closing in order to play the B/K-battery

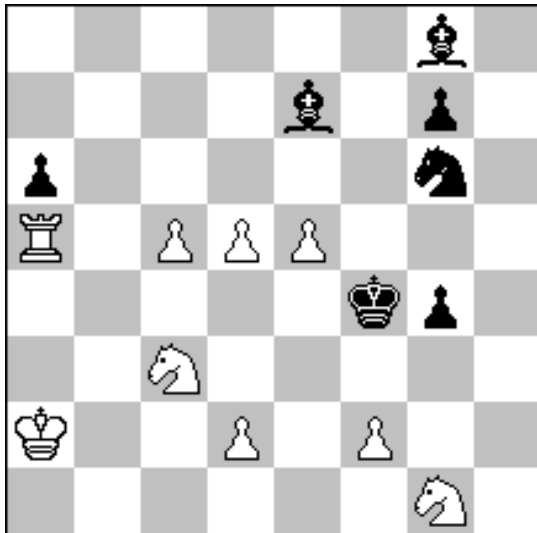
