IV. 1. Be1 g4 (C) 2. Bh4 Rg6# (A)

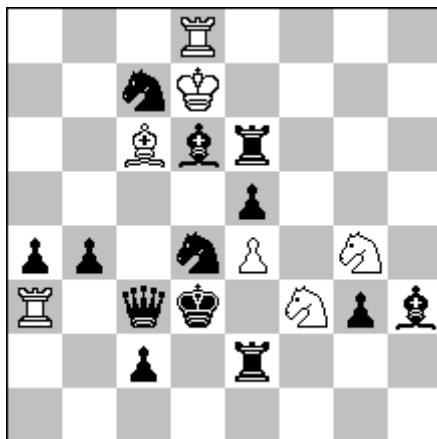
All the variants are joined by unpinning of white Rf6.

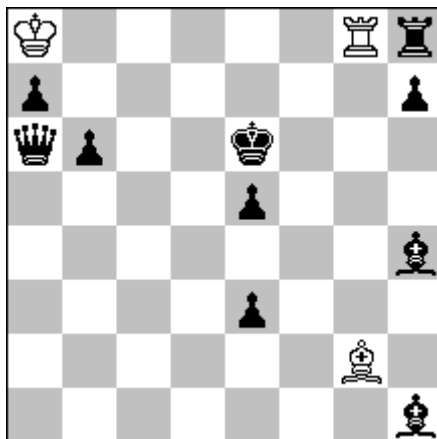
