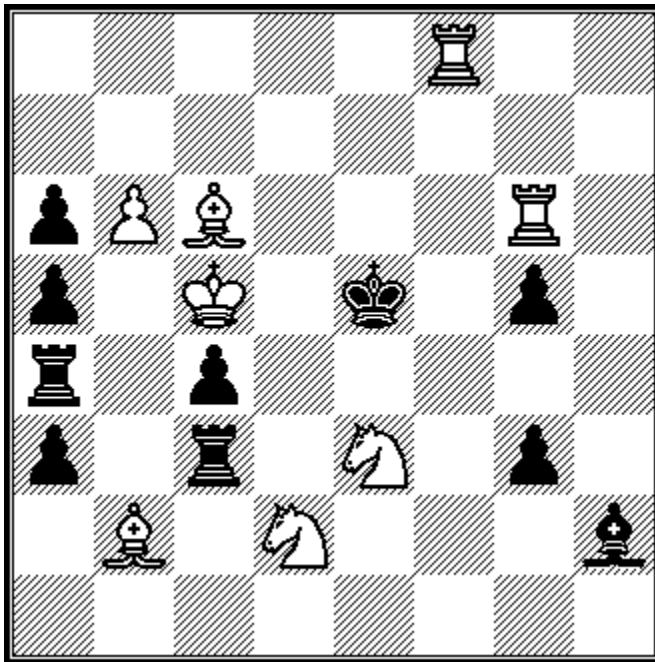
**1.Dg1!** (2.Sh4+ g:h4 3.D:g4+ L:g4#) **Tb5?!** (defense by battery creation!) **2.d5! e:d3 3.Tc4 g3 4.Sh4+ g:h4 5.Tf2+ g:f2 6.D:g4+,** that's why Black plays first **1.- e:d3! 2.Te1** and now **2.- Tb5!**, because after **3.d5 T:d5** the white rook still controls the battery. But White plays better **4.Sh4+ g:h4+ 5.Te5!** (5.- T:e5#?) and beside 5.- g3 (as above) remains only **5.- Lg5!?**, but now the rook is unpinned: **6.Te3+ f:e3 7.D:g4+ L:g4#**

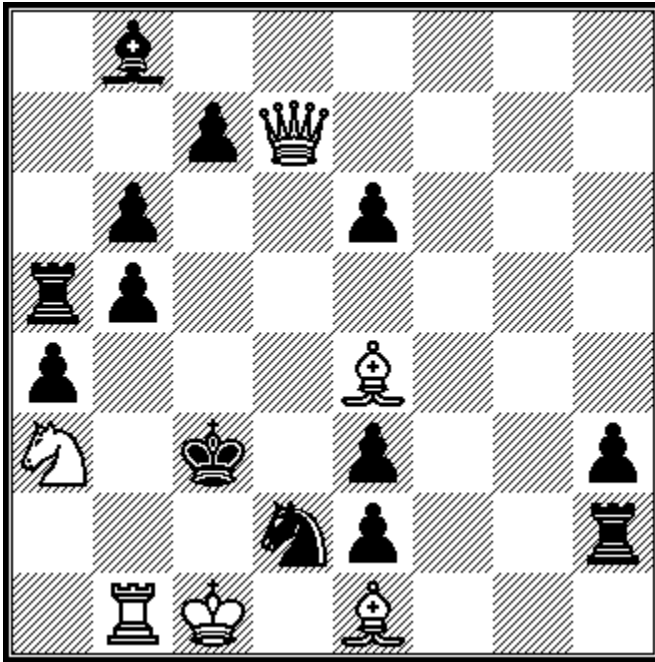
