Main plan: 1.e4? fxe3 e.p. 2.a7 e2 3.a8Q Ba7
 4.Qxa7(e4,d5,c6,b7,c8,d8,g8) 4...e1Q 5.Qa6(c4,d3)+
 Kg1 - and no decisive 6.Qxg6(g4)+ in view of own
 Pg4. That is why this Pawn will be sacrificed in
 foreplan:

 with correction of Queen's move!]

 5.Qxa7(c8)? e1Q =. Black used his own or decoyed
 opposite Pawn as an "obstacle" from decisive
 Queen's check.]

II) 4...g4+! 5.hxg4 Ba7. [Now the main plan is
 unlucky again because of wPg4 (as was in diagram
 position). But Black let White release a square h3
 on the way, and whereby White change a play
 fully.]
 6.Qh8! e1Q 7.Qh3+ Kg1 8.Qg2#.

Logical study with unusual content. In the try,
 where the main plan is unlucky, there is multiply
 ("almost random") move of White Queen. The
 foreplan gives Black a new defensive resource
 (g5-g4+) against the main plan, at that a further
 play is different depending on whether Black use
 this resource or not:

I) if Black don't use the resource then the threat
 of its executing itself corrects Queen's move in
 changeless main plan. It is something like a
 "White correction" (in a broad sense - a choice of
 one move from many) in logical study - perhaps it
 is realized firstly;

II) if Black use the resource then it refutes the
 main plan, but another weakness is detected on the
 way, and this allows White to change a play.
