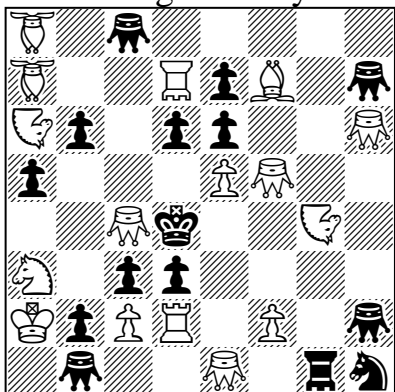

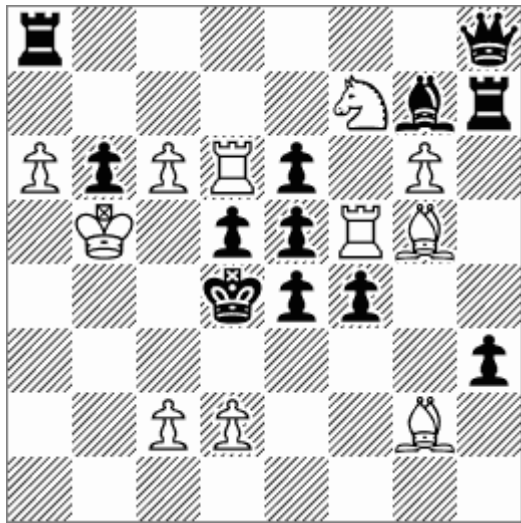
This, and the next problem, are the first examples of Rice cycle (cyclic Zagoruiko) **split into 6 phases**.

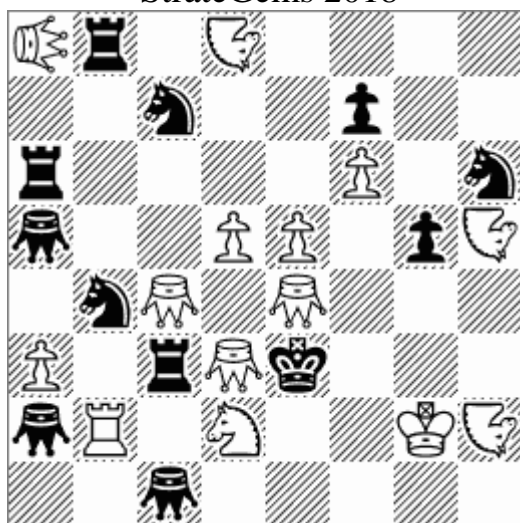

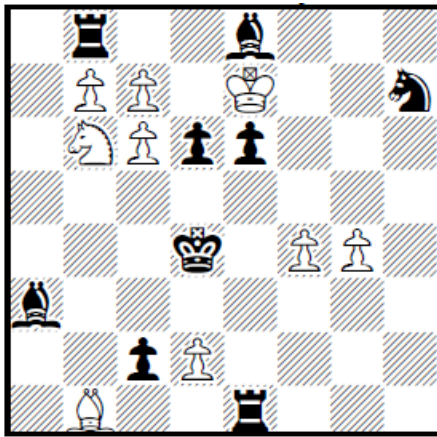

- All officers have a role in both solutions

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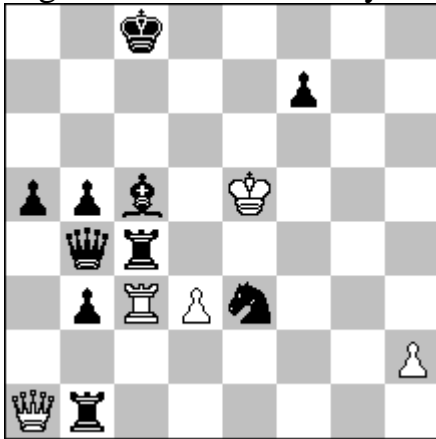

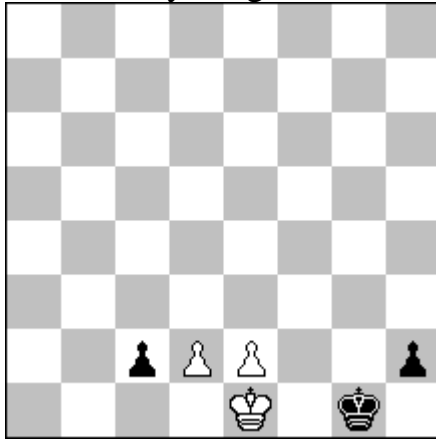
