Logical try: 1.BLe8C+? 1...RNxe8!

1.b4A! (2.e4B (3.RNb7) fxe4 e.p. 3.Bxc4)
1...d5 2.BLe8+C BLc6 3.Sb7 (2.e4B? fxe4 e.p.! 3.Bxc4? dxc4!)
1...axb4 e.p. 2.RNb6+ Kc5 3.RLd7

1.e4B! (2.BLe8C+ BLc6 3.Sb7) (2.b4A? axb4 e.p.! 3.RNb6? BLb7!)
1...d5 2.b4A (3.RNb7) axb4 e.p. 3.RNb6 (BLb7?)

Mainplan AB: b4+e4, then RNb7; Obstructions: axb4 e.p. / fxe4 e.p.
Mainplan C: BLe8+ Obstructions: BLc6 / RNxe8

Key-Threat non-reversal 1.A (2.B) / 1.B (2.A?): 1.b4A! 2.e4B and the mainplan 3.RNb7 is safeguarded after fxe4 e.p. 3.Bxc4 (Umdeutung of fxe4 e.p.) 1.e4B 2.b4A? axb4 e.p.! is a good defence. (anti-Umdeutung of axb4 e.p.)

Sequence non-reversal 1.B x 2.A / 1.A x 2.B?: 1.e4B d5 2.b4A is safeguarded after axb4 e.p. 3.RNb6. (Umdeutung of axb4 e.p.) 1.b4A d5 2.e4B? fxe4 e.p.! is a good defence. (anti-Umdeutung of fxe4 e.p.)

Dombrovskis: The logical try BLe8+C is defeated by RNxe8 (good defence). The Dresden threat after 1.e4 is to force 2...BLc6 (bad defence) 3.Sb7 instead. Black prevents this with 1...d5 by restoring the good defence (anti-Dresden). After 1.b4 d5, 2.BLe8+C is playable as black has replaced the good defence with the bad defence (Dresden).

Djurasevic theme with logical play.

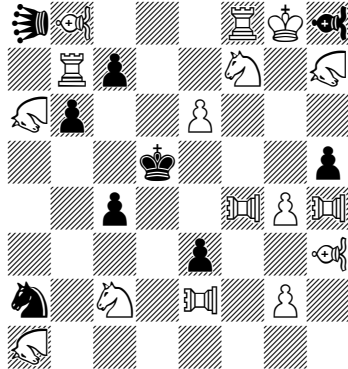

Non-reversal effect is due to necessity of (a) no flight / (b) flight.

In (b), 2.Sxe3 is threatened due to unguarded d4. Defence motivation is to unguard d6.

Transferred mate D needs departure of pawn from c7, and c5 to be (a) guarded / (b) unguarded.
