

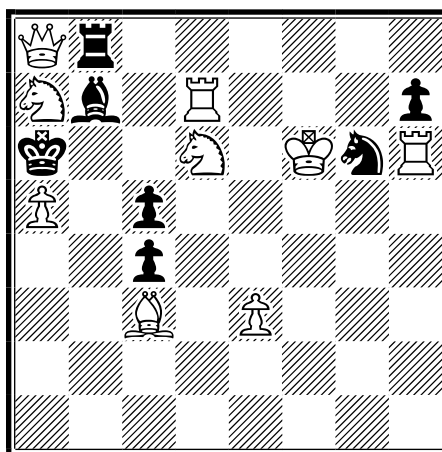

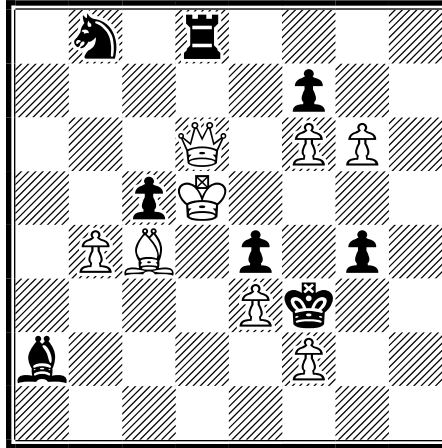

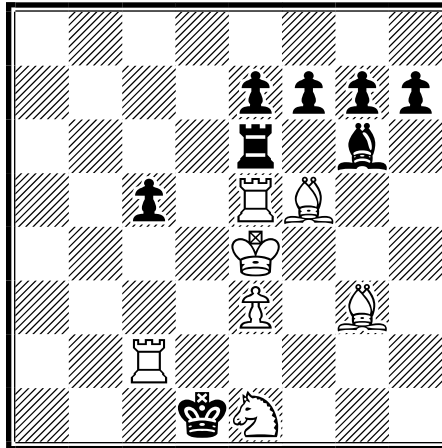

1. ...Rd6(B) 2.Rexc5 Bh5(A) 3.Ke5 Bf3 4.Bg4(b) g5 5.Rd5(a)+ Rxd5#

Function permutation between two pairs of pieces: BR/BB (supporting/delivering mate) and WRe5/WBf5 (pinning/delivering check), W-W Umnov moves, ODT, reciprocally changed moves B1/B2, reciprocally changed squares d5/g4, orthogonal-diagonal correspondence.

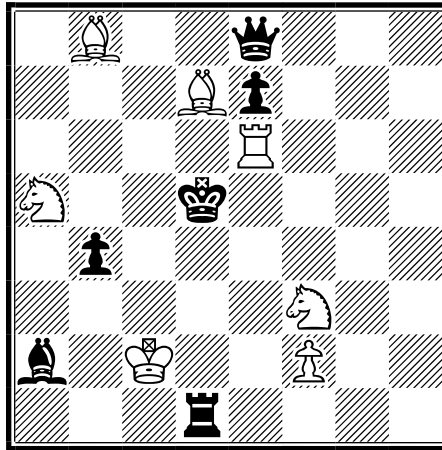

**b) 1. ...Ke4 2.Be6 Rd8! 3.Sc6(Sb3?) Qd7 4.Sd2+ Qxd2#**

Feather maneuver as a preparation for Turton doubling in the Black's play with function permutation between BR/BB (guarding flights/BQ supporting) in combination with reciprocally changed functions of white knights (guarding flight/delivering check), involving equally motivated dual-avoidances in W3.

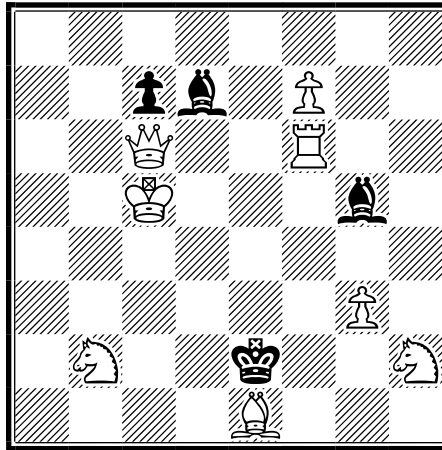

Function permutation between two black bishops (guarding flights/delivering mate), reciprocally changed functions of WR/WQ (self-block/ delivering check), BP double step, model chameleon-echo mates. Meredith.
